**Item 5(i) of agenda** Meeting called to order by the President of the Association

**Opening remarks by President**

I thank you all to have assembled here and joined this Special Council Meeting. It shows your affection, love and concern towards the Association. The present activities going on are not according to the MOA/AOA and are not good for the Association as well as for our brotherhood and unity. I welcome Past Presidents Sh. Anil Raizada, Sh. Bharat Bhasin, Sh. Lakbir Singh. Sh. H.C. Bhatia could not come as he is not well but has sent his good wishes for this meeting. Today Hony. General Secretary and Hony. Jt. General Secretary have not come to attend this important meeting. I seek your consent to appoint Sh. Vinod Behl, Past Hony. General Secretary as officiating. Hony. General Secretary for today's meeting as he is very experienced and also worked as Hony. General Secretary in the Association. The entire House approved this proposal and the President requested Sh. Vinod Behl to take over the assigned charge for today.

**Sh. Vinod Behl** I thank our President and all Council Members present in this meeting for giving me this opportunity and to proceed with the agenda of the meeting today which you all must have gone through.

Minutes of Last Council Meeting held at Bhopal on 9<sup>th</sup> April 2025 have been posted on the website of Association which all members must have gone through. In case of any amendment or correction the members can point out the same or else the minutes are presented for approval by this Council. Sh. Piyush Mishra proposed adoption of the minutes and the entire House seconded this proposal. Hence the minutes of the said Council Meeting were approved and adopted.

At this stage President intimated and clarified that the attendance of Council Members and Branch office bearers in this meeting today shall be counted and taken in consideration for eligibility in contesting the forthcoming elections as regards the minimum attending of 5 Council Meetings as mentioned in our MOA. The entire House applauded and thanked the President for this intimation in the interest of our unity and brotherhood.

**Item 5(ii) of agenda** To Examine the Award pronounced by the DRRC dated 16 May 2025 regarding dissolving the Election Commission elected at Bhopal Council meeting on 09th April 2025:-

**Sh. G.S. Mago, President** inform to the House that Since the matter is presently sub-judice, it is not appropriate to discuss on this agenda point/matter in this Special Council meeting to which the entire House gave its unanimous consent.

President inform to the House that we would discuss now various circulars circulated by CEC regarding various issue/clarification and advice which are clearly violating of MOA provision and beyond their purview for considering by the House and taking action as may be decided by the House. Agenda point 5(ii) stand amended and read as brought out above.

(a) President explained the unwarranted and undemocratic role of Election Commission by interference in HQ office working by taking over complete control of HQ i.e. all staff of HQ, email ID and website of HQ and restrained me to perform my duties as President of Association which totally disrupted the HQ office working from 26<sup>th</sup> April 2025 to 03<sup>rd</sup> May 2025. That resulted in loss of working hours and financial losses of the Association due to the staff sit idle for all these days and hence no communications /forwarding of Important policy letters to Members and correspondence with the Department could not be made which resulted in irreparable losses to the builders fraternity.

(b) The Election Commission suo moto issued a Circular No 12 dated 25 April 2025 under heading FISCAL DISCIPLINE without considering law of land and our MOA/AOA and restrained Branch Officials not to accept the Subscription in cash which is contrary to the Articles of Association.

(c) The Election Commission over stepped its vested powers conferred to it by the Articles of Association in Branch Elections which were beyond their purview and put a serious question mark on the transparency and integrity of Election Commission . I put before the House a specific example of Delhi Branch in this context which further exposes the biased work culture of the Election Commission:-

(d)(i) Election Commission in conspiracy with a group of Delhi Branch members firstly issued a Circular No 16 dated 27 April 2025 on false and fabricated complaint dated 25 April 2025 without verification of facts contained in the complaint and without verification of signatories on the complaint. It is pertinent to mention here that the complaint was based upon flimsy allegations. Even valid membership of complainants in the Association was not verified by Election Commission and in a hurry the Election Commission ignored the fact that signatory at Sr No (a) of complaint Sh Chetan Tyagi of M/s M P Tyagi was not a member of Association since terminated by the Council long back. To regularize their mistake on their part the Election Commission thereafter illegally restored the Membership of M/s M P Tyagi under Circular no. 23 dated 02 May 2025 without having any authority under our MOA/AOA to do so. This very well established the conspiracy and nexus in

between the Election Commission and a group of Delhi Branch members. Also till 27 April 2025 (when circular No 16 issued by the Election Commission) the Election Chairman of Delhi Branch was not elected/selected as per the Article No. 11(f)(vi) of AOA and even Election process in the Delhi Branch had not even commenced. The Delhi Branch convened their Executive Committee meeting on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2025 as per the Article No 11(f)(vi) of MOA/AOA and elected/selected Election Chairman for conducting the elections of Branch for 2025-2027 term . In the meeting the date and venue of meeting was also decided. Soon after receiving the minutes of meeting of Delhi Branch, the Election Commission in absolute hurry issued Circular No. 20 dated 30 April 2025 to the Branch Chairman /Hony Secretary without keeping in mind the statutory requirement to be followed as per the Article No 11(b) line No (05). Article No 11(f) (vi) & 11(f)(xiii) which are contrary to the MOA/AOA. The DRRC under article No 23(f) of MOA/AOA examined the interpretation of applicability of Article No11(f)(vi) and No11(f)(xii) on request made by Chairman Delhi branch under their letter No MBAI/DB/10/2025 dated 02 May 2025 . The DRRC under Article No 23 (f) given its interpretation in this issue vide DRRC letter No MBAI HQ/2023-2025/65 dated 15<sup>th</sup> May 2025 and accordingly the interpretation given by the DRRC under Article 23(f) of MOA/AOA which is final and binding though the interpretation of DRRC which is final and binding to all as per Article No 23(f) of MOA/AOA. Despite clearly mentioned in MOA/AOA the Election Commission issued Election schedule and venue at their own under Circular No 47 dated 16/05/2025 in gross violation of Articles of Association based upon which elections of Election Commission held.

(d)(ii) Further, the Election Commission in conspiracy with Sh. Chetan Tyagi of M/s M.P. Tyagi , made a blunder to act on complaint dated 25 April 2025 in which complainant at Srl No (a) Sh. Chetan Tyagi of M/s M P Tyagi was not a member of Association. To regularize their blunder mistake, the Election Commission issued a Circular No 23 dated 02 May 2025 under which the membership of M/s M P Tyagi was restored without having any authority to do so in gross violation of Articles of Association. The same was countermanded by the President of Association but Election Commission ignored the directions of President of Association.

(d)(iii) In Bareilly Branch elections the Election Commission did not allow the membership of 10 members to whom membership had been accorded by President of Association based upon the decision of Council which is supreme decision making body which created disputes in Bareilly Branch elections and the aggravated group of members approached the DRRC. We apprehend litigation in this matter appears inevitable and which will ultimately put burden on the funds of our Association and lead to re-election in Bareilly Branch.

(d)(iv) In some other Branches viz Tejpur, Karwar, Guwahati, Gwalior etc the unwanted interference of the Election Commission caused many disputes/eligible voters were not allowed to cast their votes.

(e) The very serious act of violation of Article No 24.4 given on page No 34 of Memorandum and Articles of Association of M.E.S.BUILDERS ASSOCIATION OF INDIA (Regd.) had been committed by the Election Commission by issuing Election

circular No 39 dated 12 May 2025. The Election Commission illegally altered and flouted the Article of Association No 12.3(c) which pertains to requirement of attending minimum 05 Council meetings in two years term to become eligible to contest in their Branch Elections in contravention to the Article No 24.4 given on page No 34 of AOA which is a serious lapse on the part of Election Commission. It also proves the Election Commission's intention to not to conduct free and fair Elections and to support one group of contestants which is totally an unconstitutional act of Election Commission. As such if Branches follow this type of illegal Instructions issued by the Election Commission in contravention to the laid down rules under Article of Association No 12.3(c), that will creates massive disputes at Branch levels as well as at HQ level which will damage the reputation of Association and open flood gates of litigations which will put extra burden on HQ funds unnecessarily to support a particular group of members of their choice by the Election Commission.

(e) Apart from the above irregularities a serious lapse committed by the Election Commission in declaration of Branch Election results. It a shocking fact to note that Election Commission declared the result of one Branch (Nasirabad Branch) which never existed as on 31 Mar 2025 but without verification of facts the Election Commission declared the results and uploaded on MES BAI website which is a serious lapse on the part of Election Commission and beyond their charter of duties under Article No 11(e)(v).

**Sh. Ravi Kant** of Karwar Branch expressed his pain that some very senior Past leaders are directly indulging in undesired mudslinging, extending support to infighting, being active in approaching the Courts without even abiding by the stipulations contained in our MOA/AOA and creating undesired groupism merely to ensure that their favourite ones win the elections for reaping benefits.

The entire House agreed with Sh. Ravi Kant and expressed concern and pain on these developments when the situation demands sincere service for the cause of builders irrespective of any so called factionalism.

**Sh. Kumar Ashok** : The HQ team of 2023-2025 faced serious problems because of seizure of Bank accounts, sending letters to E-in-C and resorting to other such activities by that group to humiliate the Association. We have brought very positive reforms for the builders which they always oppose and they even leave the Council Meeting while it still going on.

**Sh. C. Balasatish** : The CEC team elected in Bhopal Council Meeting issued circulars without abiding by our MOA like flouting the clause of attending minimum 5 Council Meetings.

**Sh. V.P. Sanjeev** : I worked as CEC and also as Chairman of MOA committee. CEC has a limited area to indulge which is regarding elections and to conduct them as per our MOA. The duties of observers is to observe and report to CEC instead of going to Branches and to circulate minutes.

**Sh. Badri Mandar :** A mistake was done in Bhopal and I said repeatedly that we should not go against our MOA by electing a Past President as CEC and the policy of attending minimum 5 Council Meetings should be strictly followed which the CEC team flouted and issued unwarranted decisions.

**Sh. Vishnu T.P. Karta :** I have one question regarding who is the supreme body of our Association. This House is undoubtedly our supreme body in which we take decisions and form rules which are approved in the AGM.

**Sh. Manoj Kumar Gupta :** No person can be on a post if he/she defies our MOA. If we have received objections about today's meeting from Branches the question is whether their Executive Body/ General Body have approved the same. In fact these letters appear to be doubtful because of their members being present today in this Special Council Meeting and also that the language and format of these objections are identical as if received from the same source and under compulsion. Hence I request that these objections should not be considered as are against the stipulations and factual position.

**Sh. Harpal Singh :** CEC intimated that branches should not receive cash payment as dues from the members. While in Bareilly branch about cash payment from 14 members was received and no statement or details of transactions was issued. Hence I request for re-election in Bareilly branch at the earliest as number of new members whose membership has been approved in the Council Meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> Feb 2025 and recorded in Minutes of Council Meeting. HQ have issued a factual note to CEC in this regard and uploaded in MESBAI website but voting rights was not given to them.

**Sh. Piyush Mishra :** It is regretted that those against have not come in the meeting today or else an acceptable solution could have been arrived at.

President noted the views and points brought forward by the worthy members and assured that every rightful issue shall be looked after in the interest of the entire builder community without any prejudice or ill will.

President requested to the Council to decide further course of action on the basis of above deliberation and facts on record.

The House with one voice demanded dissolution of CEC team elected at Bhopal Council Meeting with immediate effect and new CEC team be elected in this Special Council Meeting.

President sought approval of the House in this matter the entire House proposed and seconded this proposal with voice vote which was therefore adopted and confirmed.

**Sh. C. Balasatish** Vice President E-class proposed the following resolution and read it to the House.

### **RESOLUTION**

"The Council unanimously resolved in the Special Council meeting of M.E.S. Builders Association of India (Regd.) held on 02 Jun 2025 at Hotel Signature Grand, 1A, Sub District Centre, Hari Nagar, New Delhi-110064 that the Election Commission Elected at Bhopal Council Meeting with Sh Praveen Mahana as Chief Election Commissioner, Sh Naveen Kumar Yadav and Sh Amit Bhaduri as Election Commissioner is functioning in totally Biased and Unconstitutional manner to Favor particular Group of Members of their Choice. It is well established from the N number of irregularities, biased favouritism and passing orders contrary to Memorandum and Articles of Association of M E S BUILDERS ASSOCIATION OF INDIA (REGD) as amended upto 31/07/2024.

The Council further recorded that the Council is competent to dissolve the elected Election Commission which was elected by itself in the Bhopal Council Meeting i.e. by the Council members in view of stipulations contained in our MOA/AOA.

The Council unanimously further resolved to dissolve the Election Commission comprising of Sh Praveen Mahana as Chief Election Commissioner, Sh Naveen Kumar Yadav and Sh Amit Bhaduri as Election Commissioner with immediate effect from today 02 Jun 2025 onwards since it is not conducting the ongoing elections as per provisions laid down under the Constitution (MOA/AOA as amended up to 31/07/2024) of Association. As such the Election Commission elected in Bhopal Council meeting held on 09 April 2025 is not functioning for conducting elections of Branches and HQ Office Bearers in free and fair manner which is a primary requirement.

The Council Further authorized the President of Association to conduct fresh elections of Election Commission Immediately as per agenda point No 5(ii) as per Resolution passed and approved by the House.

It is further resolved to authorize the newly elected Election Commission to conduct fresh elections strictly as per the Memorandum and Articles of Association of M.E.S.BUILDERS ASSOCIATION OF INDIA (Regd.) as amended up to 31/07/2024. Wherever Branch elections have already been held before the dissolution of Election Commission comprising of Sh Praveen Mahana as Chief Election Commissioner, Sh Naveen Kumar Yadav and Sh Amit Bhaduri as Election Commissioners based on the merit by keeping in that elections already held in any Branch conducted by adhering to all Articles of Association in their Election process. No Branch Elections already conducted will be cancelled by the newly Elected Commission if held strictly by following provisions of Articles of Association for each post. However if any member has been elected against the stipulations contained in our MOA/AOA a new incumbent shall be elected by the Branch in his/her place. If in any branch election held for 2025-2027 term the legitimate voters were not allowed to participate, the entire election process shall be performed a fresh strictly as per MOA/AOA.

It is further resolved to authorize the elected Election Commission to decide fresh election schedule for Branches and in the HQ Office Bearers elections.

The entire House approved this resolution and sought formation of new team of Election Commission.

**Sh. Vinod Behl** thanked President and as per Resolution passed just now by the entire House with one voice intimated to the House to constitute New Election Commission by selection / Election as per the Articles of Association and said that the present extra ordinary situation had been arisen due to various acts/omissions committed by the Election Commission in gross violation of Articles of Association which is known to all the members.

For the post of Chief Election Commissioner the name of Sh. Narendra Kumar Gupta of Jhansi Branch was proposed by Sh. V.P. Sanjeev and seconded by Sh. Manoj Gupta and many other members. President asked for any other nomination for the post but since no other proposal came Sh. Narendra Kumar Gupta was unanimously elected unopposed as Chief Election Commissioner and the entire House gave him a standing ovation amidst thunderous applause.

Next the House was requested to propose names of two Election Commissioners to assist the Chief Election Commissioner.

The name of Sh. R.M. Singhvi of Jodhpur Branch was proposed by Sh. Piyush Mishra and seconded by entire House.

The name of Sh. Prem Nath Roy of Barrackpore Branch was proposed by Sh. Vivek Jhavar and seconded by entire House.

The name of Sh. Piyush Mishra was proposed by Sh. Dharmendra Vasandani and seconded by Sh. Ranbir Singh Bawa.

**Sh. Piyush Mishra** graciously thanked the House and excused himself from becoming Election Commissioner which was applauded by the entire House.

There being no other proposals and objections Sh. R.M. Singhvi and Sh. Prem Nath Roy were unanimously elected unopposed as Election Commissioners as per stipulations contained in our MOA/AOA.


The entire House applauded and wished them the best for conducting free and fair elections strictly as per our MOA/AOA.

Sh. Narendra Kumar Gupta (Chief Election Commissioner), Sh. R.M. Singhvi and Sh. Prem Nath Roy (Election Commissioners) stood up to acknowledge their gratitude to the entire House and the dais for having given them this opportunity to serve the Association.

**Sh.
